Simon and Martina are ① a married couple from Canada. They were both students when they first met at the University of Toronto through a common friend. After graduating from the university, they moved together to South Korea, where ② (work, them, to, of, started, both) as English teachers. At the same time, they began to take videos of themselves and their adventures in Seoul to share with their families and friends in Canada, and uploaded ③ them online. They would do simple things, like going shopping, ordering food at restaurants, and traveling around South Korea. People who were interested in visiting the country saw the videos, and many others around the world began watching their videos as well. After ④ half a decade of living, working, and making videos, they have now become a famous internet couple on the video sharing site, *YouTube*. ⑤ Because of their popularity, they both quit teaching English and now work on their online video channel full time. But since they didn't have enough money, they organized a fundraiser with a goal of \$40,000 to buy a studio in Seoul to film in. Their fans donated over \$100,000 in total, and now they make many videos a week, and are even going to open a coffee shop for their visiting fans later this year.

Now their channel, *Eat Your Kimchi*, has over ⑥ 500,000 subscribers and they continue to share their love of their adoptive country with the world in English. Their work is helpful for people who are interested in K-Pop, Korean Pop music, which is becoming more and more popular in North America and across Europe, and they have fans ⑦ ( ) as well.
